

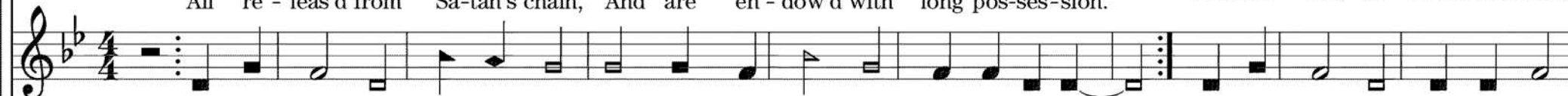

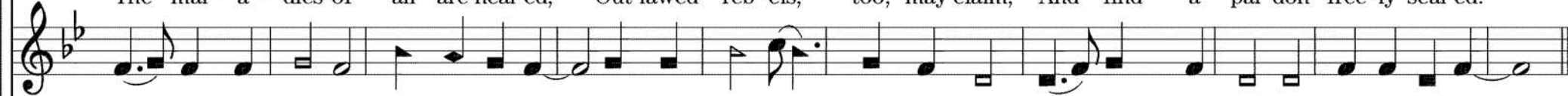
1. They who long in sin have lain, And felt the hand of dire op-pres-sion, Sick and sore, the blind and lame,
