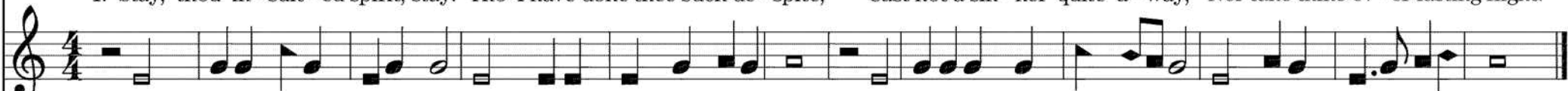


C Major. Charles Wesley, 1749.

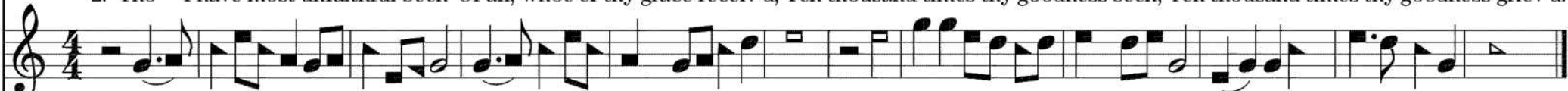
