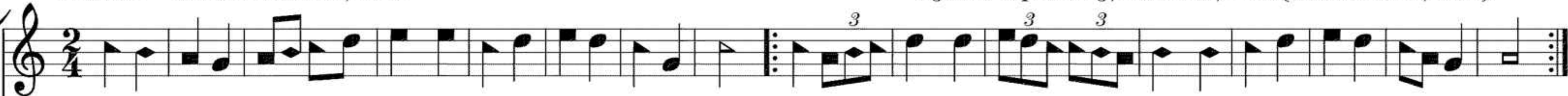
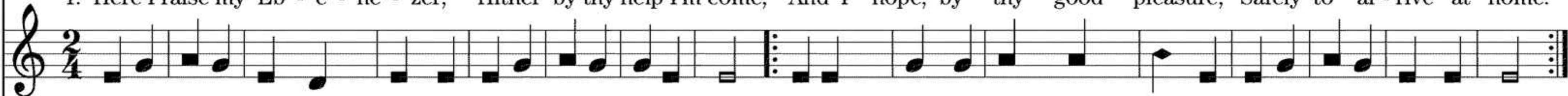


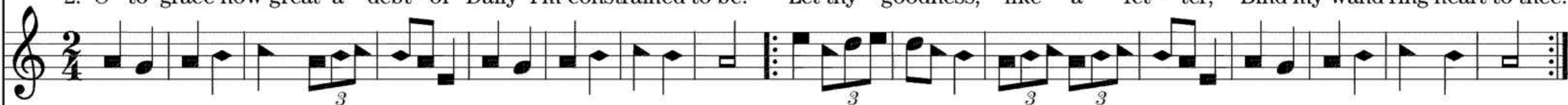
A Minor. Robert Robinson, 1758.
